To join us "live", you can log on to Facebook at 10:00 A.M. **This is the only way to watch it live!!!**

- On your device, go to [facebook.com](https://www.facebook.com)
- Log in to your account, or go to "Create An Account" and follow the prompts.
- Type **New Life Christian Church** in the search bar (marked by the outline of a magnifying glass)
- Remember, **you can't get us on livestream until we are live**, which begins at 9:55 A.M. on Facebook.
